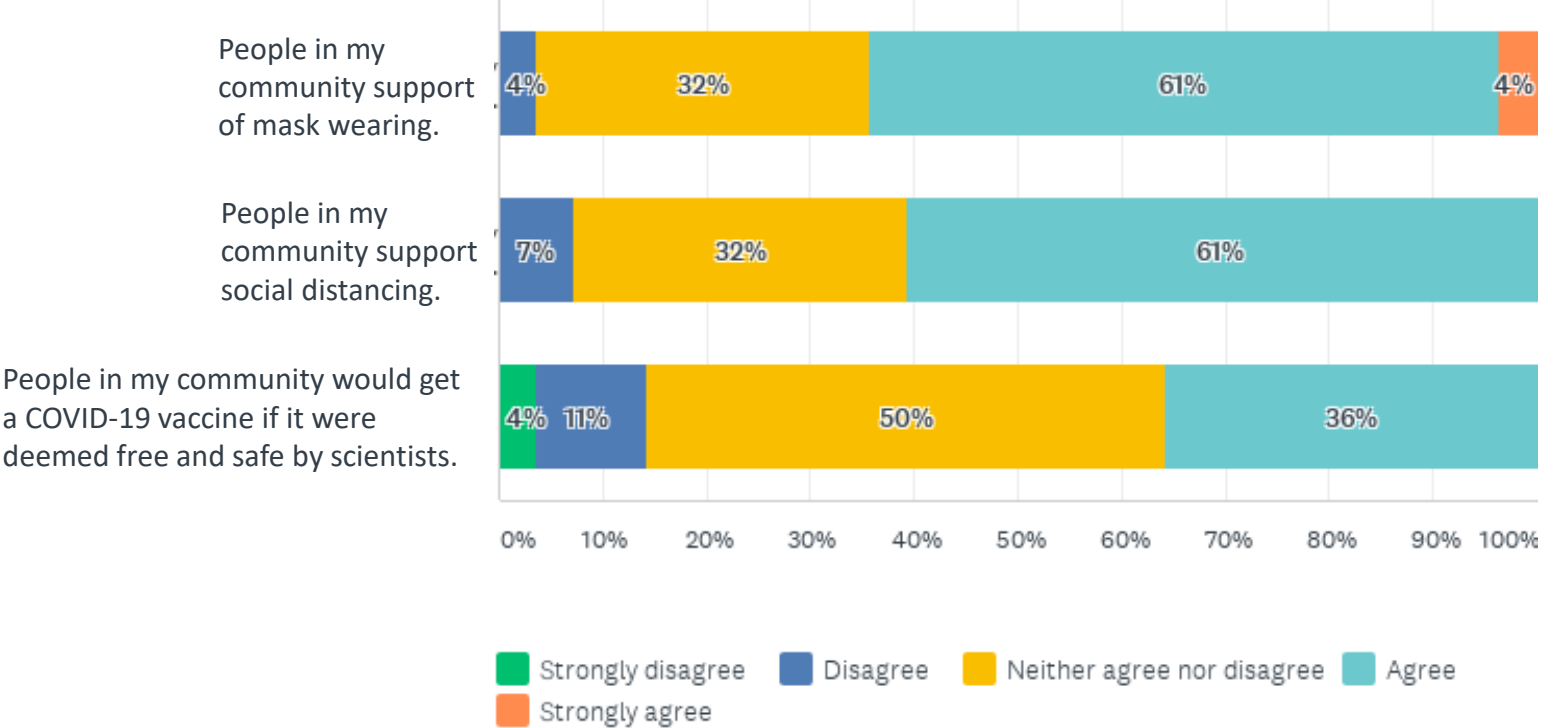

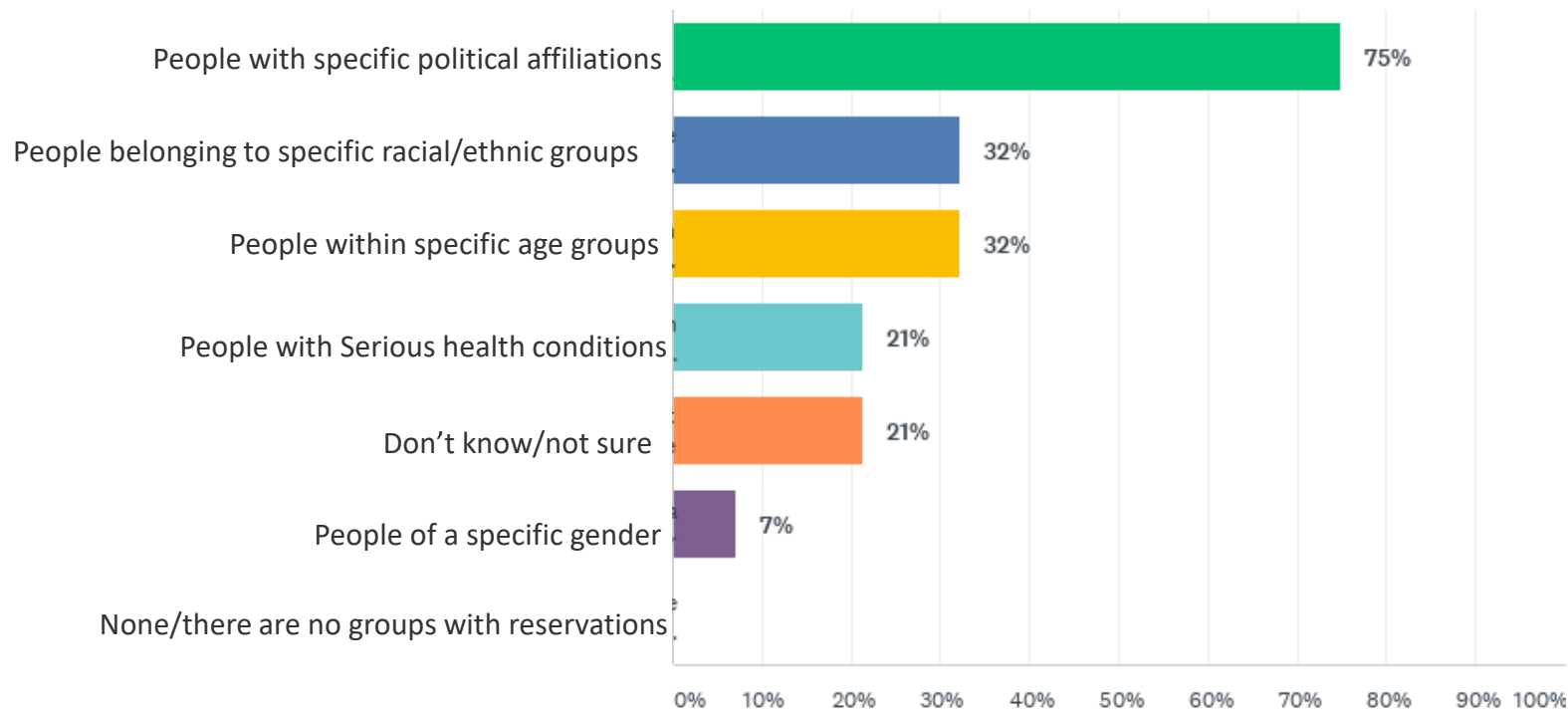

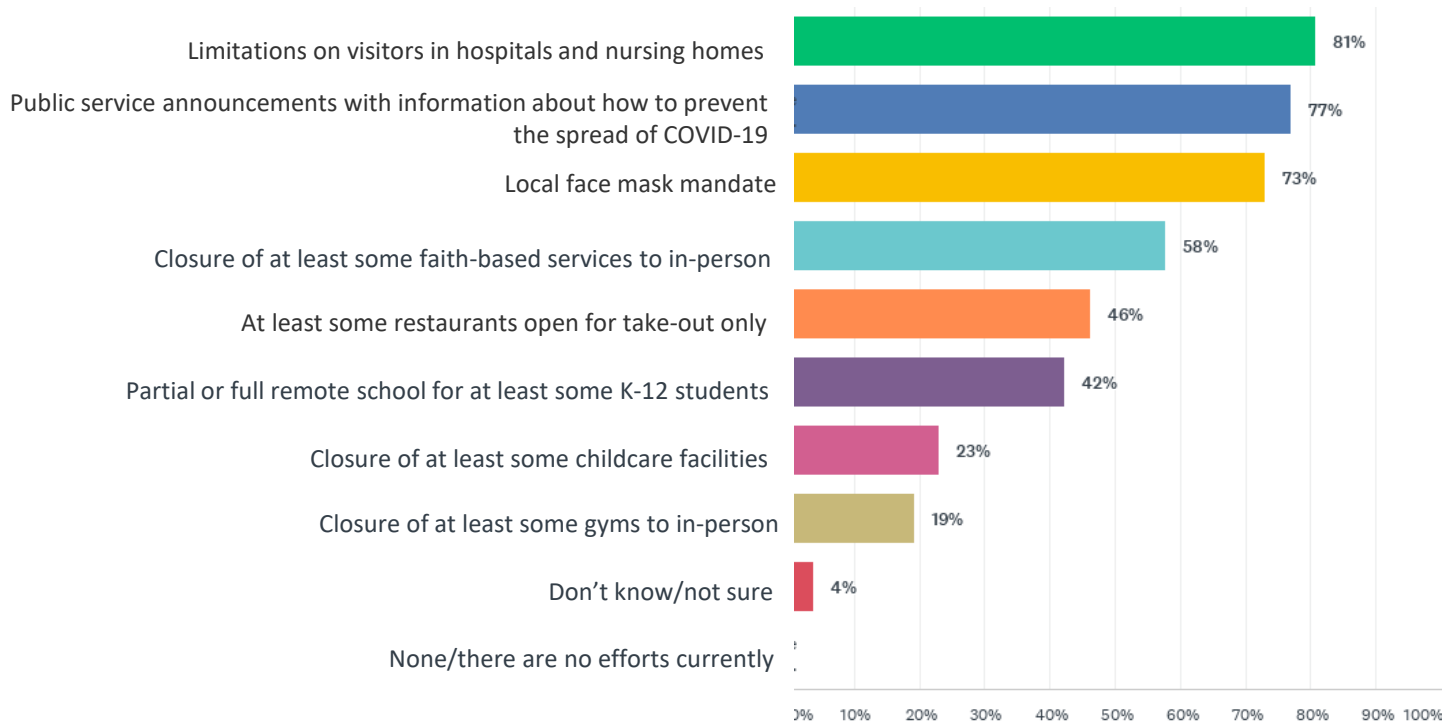

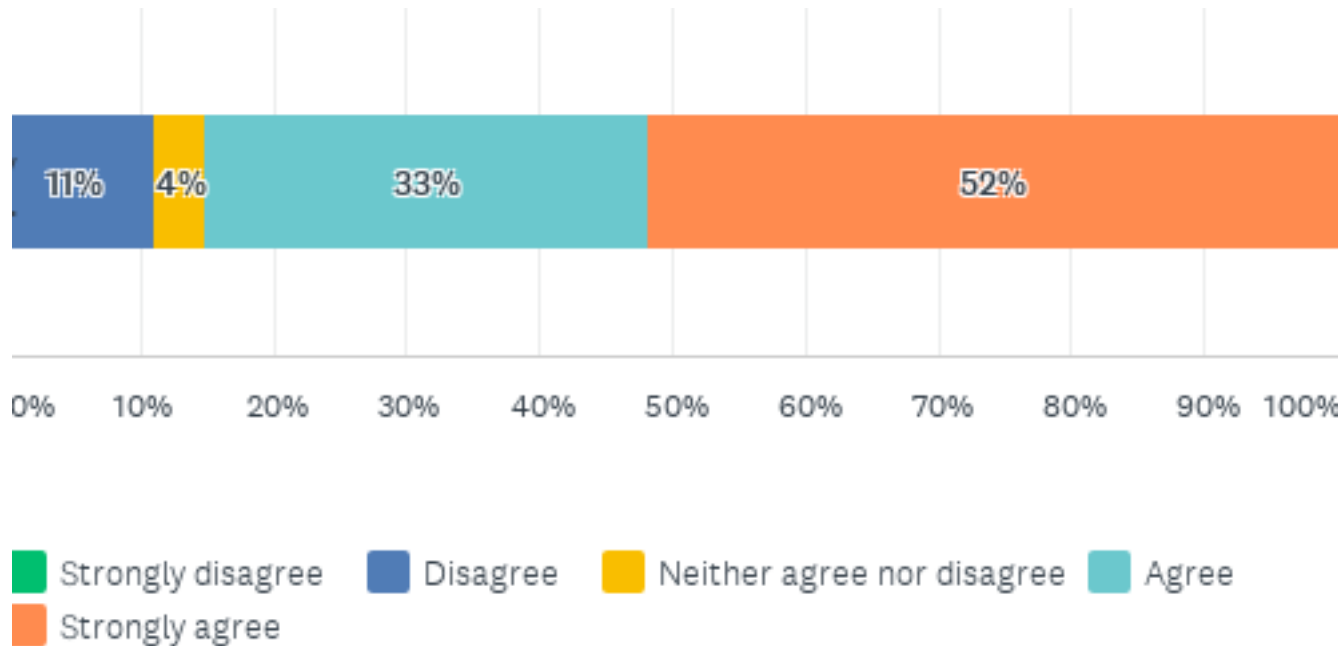

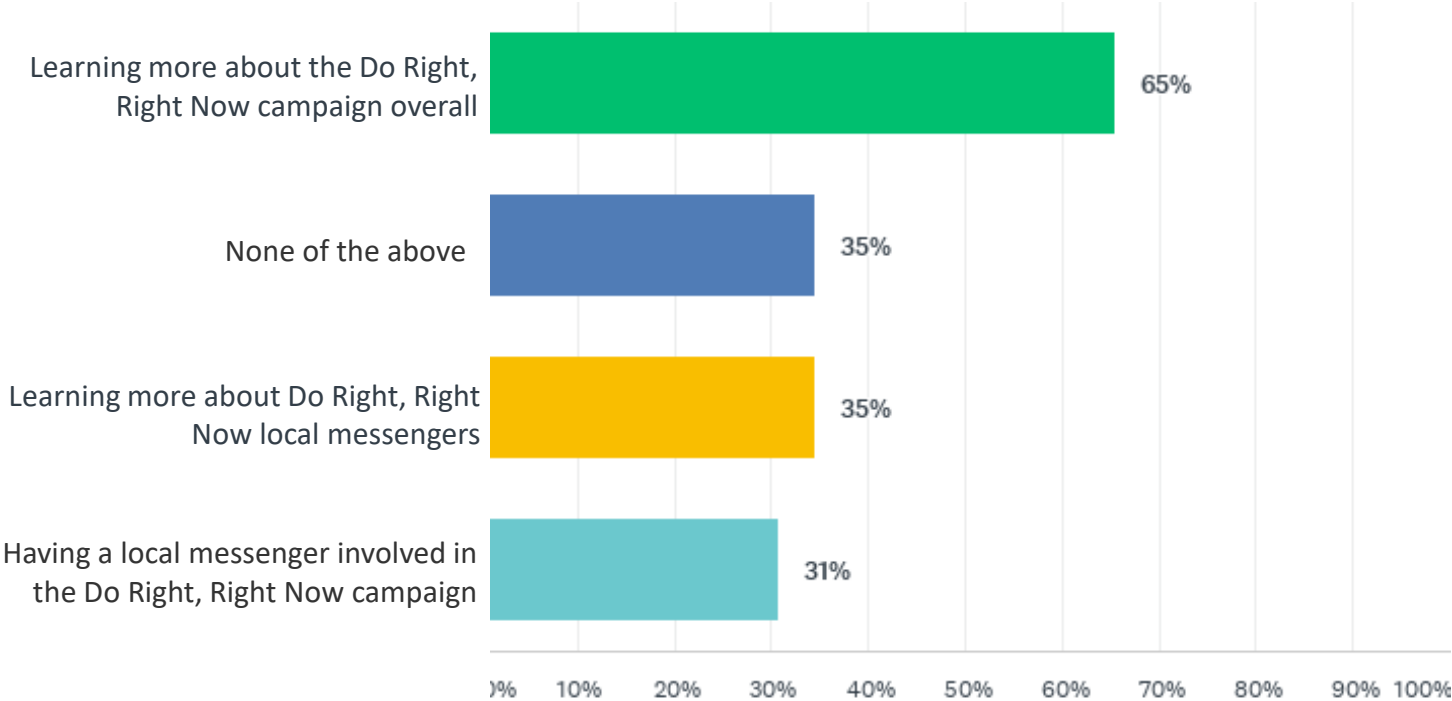

# Methodology Notes

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- Recipients: This survey was sent via email to all participants on the Thursday Statewide Central Navigation Calls, which are hosted by Nebraska Children.
- Response rate: There were 150 people on the email (including 8 people on the cc line). The survey response rate is 19% (28/150).
- Timing: The survey was sent on Wednesday, December 30, 2020. A reminder to complete the survey was provided verbally on the Thursday, January 7 Statewide Central Navigation call. The survey was closed Friday, January 8.
- Purpose of the survey: The purpose of the survey was to generate a list of people who are interested in learning more about the Do Right, Right Now campaign and/or becoming more actively involved with this campaign, and 2) to understand current attitudes and efforts related to COVID-19 in communities across the state
- Limitations: This survey was fielded using a convenience sample; as such, results are not generalizable to a larger population and are not necessarily representative of the perspective of a larger population.
- Survey introduction: Below is the survey introduction
